
WHAT IS THE INDEX OF ECONOMIC FREEDOM?


The Index of Economic Freedom measures jurisdictions against each other in terms of trade freedom, tax burden, judicial effectiveness, and so on. These factors may be weighted according to their influence on economic freedom and compiled into a single score that allows for a ranking. The ranking can be done on a country basis or can look at wider regions or smaller sub-national units like states. In 2024 edition, this index covers 184 countries from across the globe.





WHAT IS THE FM GLOBAL RESILIENCE INDEX?








WHAT IS THE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT REPORT?







WHAT IS THE IMD WORLD TALENT RANKING?



World Talent Ranking Factors
















WHAT IS THE GOVERNMENT AI READINESS INDEX?












WHAT IS THE NETWORKED READINESS INDEX (NRI)?


Networked Readiness Index (NRI) 2023 is a global report that was first published in 2002 as part of the Global Information Technology Report (GITR) published by the World Economic Forum, Cornell University, and INSTEAD. In 2019, it was redesigned under the auspices of the Portulans Institute, to promote integration between technology, people and governance, for achieving positive impact on economy, society and the environment, through 4 pillars, 12 sub-pillars, 60 indicators. The index covers 134 countries this year.






WHAT IS THE CLIMATE CHANGE PERFORMANCE INDEX?

The Climate Change Performance Index 2024 is an instrument designed to enhance transparency in international politics. Its aim is to put political and social pressure on those countries which have, up until now, failed to take ambitious action on climate protection. The report evaluates and compares the climate protection performance of 59 countries and the European Union (EU), which collectively account for more than 92% of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

WHAT IS THE GLOBAL BUSINESS BRIBERY RISK INDEX?

Global Business Bribery Risk Index 2023 is a global index dedicated to measuring business bribery risk in 194 countries, considering 4 main domains in this regard, namely: interactions with governments, anti- bribery deterrence and enforcement, governmental and civil service transparency, and capacity for civil oversight.

DOMAIN ONE

Reflects the risk associated with business interactions with government agencies, including three subdomains measuring the frequency of government interaction, the degree to which bribery is expected and tolerated in such interactions, and the overall regulatory burden.

DOMAIN TWO

Measures a country's ability to deter and prosecute bribery offenses. It comprises subdomains reflecting both societal disapproval and the enforcement of antibribery laws.

DOMAIN THREE

Addresses the attributes of government administration, relying in particular on measures of transparency with respect to the government budget and potential financial conflicts.

DOMAIN FOUR

Captures the role played by non-governmental actors in monitoring and controlling corruption, including the critical role of the media and a broad-based measure of the civil society capacity of a country's population.




WHAT IS THE CORRUPTION PERCEPTIONS INDEX?

Corruption Perceptions index 2023, which ranks 180 countries and territories by their perceived levels of public sector corruption according to experts and businesspeople, aggregates data from a number of different sources that provide perceptions by business people and country experts of the level of corruption in the public sector.

The following steps are followed to calculate the CPI:

- 1- Select data sources: Each data source that is used to construct the CPI must fulfill the criteria to qualify as a valid source:
- 2- Standardise data sources to a scale of 0-100 where a 0 equals the highest level of perceived corruption and 100 equals the lowest level of perceived corruption.
- 3- Calculate the average: For a country or territory to be included in the CPI, a minimum of three sources must assess that country.
- 4- Report a measure of uncertainty: The CPI is accompanied by a standard error and confidence interval associated with the score, which captures the variation in scores of the data sources available for that country/territory.





WHAT IS THE GLOBAL GENDER GAP REPORT?

Global Gender Gap Report 2024 is designed to "measure gender-based gaps in access to resources and opportunities in countries rather than the actual levels of the available resources and opportunities in those countries. Currently, the report covers 146 economies around the globe, over 93% of the world's population.

The report examines four overall areas of inequality between men and women:

- Economic participation and opportunity –outcomes on salaries, participation levels and access to high-skilled employment
- Educational attainment –outcomes on access to basic and higher level education
- Political empowerment –outcomes on representation in decision-making structures
- Health and survival -outcomes on life expectancy and sex ratio.








WHAT IS THE WORLD HAPPINESS REPORT?
